

## Local Information

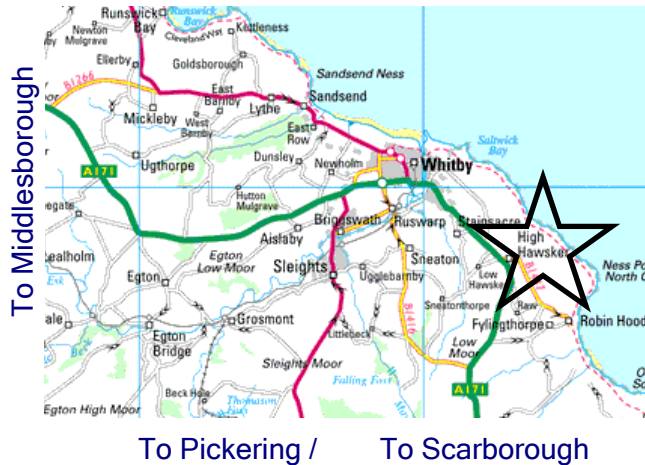
The village of High Hawsker is situated in between Whitby and Robin Hood's Bay, two and a half miles from each, and is ideally situated to explore the area. The village has a pleasant atmosphere, and the locals are very friendly people. A drink and a meal can be enjoyed in the Hare & Hounds Inn, which is about 50 yards from the house; there is also a games-room that can be used by the whole family. The village hall, which is situated about 100 yards from the property, has a playground.



Historic Whitby with its beautiful harbour and little alleys and streets is one of the most atmospheric towns in the area. The town is built on the mouth of the river Esk, the only Salmon River in Yorkshire, and has strong connections with Captain Cook, Dracula, and the photographer Frank Meadow Sutcliffe. Visitors to Whitby will find that it is a place they want to come back to. What you cannot miss on your visit to Whitby is Whitby Abbey, which is a magnificent site on your entry into the area.

If you like museums you will enjoy a visit to one of Whitby's many museums. Among others, the Captain Cook Memorial Museum, the Whitby Museum (a treasure trove of Whitby's past), and the lifeboat museum. Whitby also has a number of Galleries, which are worth a visit. Other places, which are certainly worth a visit are, Robin Hood's Bay, Runswick Bay, Scarborough, Danby Moors Center, Falling Foss Waterfall, Grosmont from which the steam train to Pickering runs, etc.

The area around High Hawsker is ideal for cycling or walking. There are many public footpaths and bridleways. A cycle hire center is just a short walk from Grange Farm. Other activities within a 5 miles radius are Rowing, Canoeing, Swimming, Golfing and Riding. Whatever your interests, there will be something for you.

# Grange Farm



Grange Farm is really spacious, well-furnished, comfortable and full of character. The house is a mid 18th Century Yorkshire Stone Farmhouse and offers accommodation, for maximum 14 persons + 2 Cots. The accommodation is excellent for families/friends wanting to holiday together. It is an ideal base to explore the Yorkshire Coast and the North Yorkshire Moors.

Grange Farm in the village of High Hawsker, which is in the North York Moors National Park, mid way between Whitby and Robin Hood's Bay. Approximately 2.5 miles from each.



The house has five bedrooms and two sitting rooms. One sitting room has a gas 'wood-burner effect' fire; this room also has a TV, video, DVD Player, and stereo/radio/cassette/CD. The second sitting room (we call it the yellow room) has a high vaulted beamed ceiling. The spacious dining room has an open fire.

The kitchen is well-equipped. It has a large fridge/freezer, 110 cm wide gas oven/cooker, microwave, and dishwasher. There is a utility room which has a washing machine and tumble dryer. An iron and ironing-board are also provided.

The dining room is next to the kitchen.



There also is a conservatory, which gives entrance to a south facing fenced garden and patio with garden furniture and barbeque.

First floor: two family rooms (double bed and full-size bunk-beds), two twin rooms, bathroom/WC, separate WC.

Second Floor: attic conversion (sloping ceiling), into an excellent double bedroom and en-suite bathroom/W.C. All the bedrooms have a TV and a washbasin. Linen (duvets) is included. Towels can be provided at extra cost.

Electric, full gas central heating and hot water is included.

Two cots & two high chairs are available.

**PARKING:** Please note it is essential that all prospective clients are aware when making a booking that we offer parking for a maximum of 4 vehicles. Due to the size and the lay out of the village no other convenient parking is available.

Sorry, but no smoking, and no pets.

On the starting day of your holiday, you can enter the house at 4 pm. On the day of departure, please leave by 10 am.

How to find us:

By road:

From Whitby (about 2.5 miles) turn left into High Hawsker, then 1st house on the right. From Scarborough turn right into High Hawsker, at main road through village, turn left, house is 200 yards on the left.

By public transport:

The nearest train station is in Whitby. The train station in Scarborough also has a good bus connection to High Hawsker. Bus 93(a) which runs between Whitby to Scarborough passes through High Hawsker. The bus stop is half a minute walk from the house.
